The aim of the **Flight Medical Crew study day** is to update and expand on existing knowledge in retrieval and transport medicine. Delegates should ideally have previous flight crew / flight nursing experience and be interested in debate and discussion of current hot topics. However, nurses, doctors and paramedics interested to work in this exciting subspecialty are also welcome to attend as a possible entry point in to the industry.

This training day follows up as a successor of the earlier **CCAT Flight Nurse Study Days**, held since 2011, and we are very grateful to the St Katherine's Educational Foundation at Cumberland Lodge where the meeting is held. This unique and fabulous backdrop is one of the Royal lodges of Windsor Great Park, recently made famous in the film of the abdication of King Edward VIII ('Kings Speech'). Cumberland Lodge is adjacent to the home of the Queen at Windsor Castle, near to London's Heathrow Airport.
