Retrieval and Transfer Medicine

Designed for those who intend to become medical crew members for Helicopter Emergency Medical Services (HEMS), Search and Rescue (SAR) or inter-hospital rotary wing transport, and for anyone who wants to know more about dealing with ill and injured passengers on board helicopter air ambulances, and about being part of the flight crew team.

Although the **HMFC** course can be taken as a stand-alone package, it follows immediately after, and is a supplement to, the **CCAT Foundation Level** course. It has been designed to introduce medical, nursing and paramedical personnel to the practical aeronautical aspects of working in the helicopter environment. **HMFC** also forms part of our preparation package for the Diploma in Retrieval and Transfer Medicine examination of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh and other similar exams. Successful students will be prepared to the standard recognised by the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) in its published recommendations for helicopter air ambulance operations: Annex V, Part SPA, Subpart J (HEMS.100 to 155).
