### For those who want to know more about dealing with ill and injured passengers on board commercial aircraft

The **MEF** course is a response to intense professional interest in the subject of responding to a call for medical assistance when flying. Participants come from a wide range of medical specialties. The two most popular reasons given for attendance are:

- I have been asked to volunteer on a previous flight
- I travel very frequently, and I am concerned that I may be asked to volunteer

The venue is Cumberland Lodge, a unique and fabulous setting. The Lodge is one of the Royal houses of Windsor Great Park, recently made famous in the film of the abdication of King Edward VIII ('Kings Speech'). Cumberland Lodge is adjacent to the home of the Queen at Windsor Castle, near to London's Heathrow Airport.

A second day is offered as an option for those interested in visiting an airline for 'behind the scenes' training.

#### Programmed activities:

- Altitude physiology - the special aviation environment
- Epidemiology of medical emergencies in aircraft
- Medical equipment on board aircraft
- Oxygen systems and availability
- Cabin crew - their roles and first aid training
- Management of common emergencies in flight
- 'Is there a doctor on board?' - The medico-legal issues
- Safety on board
- Safety - aircraft escape and evacuation
- CPR / ALS in the passenger cabin
