Clinical Care in the Air

The aim of the **Paediatric Aeromedical Transfer study day** is to update and expand on existing knowledge in the retrieval and transport of babies and children. Delegates should ideally have previous patient transport experience and be interested in debate and discussion of current hot topics in paediatrics and neonatal medicine. However, nurses, doctors and paramedics interested to work in this exciting subspecialty are also welcome to attend as a possible entry point in to the subspecialty of patient transport.

This course is also vital for those health care practitioners who only occasionally transport children. Using skills workshops and discussion groups, as well as didactic lectures, it serves as an excellent platform for maintaining currency in the skills of patient retrieval.
